Mr. Glenn Edward McAlhany, 90 years of age, died Tuesday, August 8, 2017. Glenn was born in Branchville, a son of the late Edward S. McAlhany and Pearle Shuler McAlhany. He was a member of Branchville United Methodist Church for over 60 years, where he held numerous leadership roles. He loved farming, gardening, and was an avid hunter.
