Mr. Harry "Doc" Harriott, 77 years of age, died Monday, November 23, 2009, at The Regional Medical Center in Orangeburg. Mr. Harriott was born in Hampton Co., a son of the late Heyward Harriott and Carrie Chesser Harriott. Mr. Harriott was a member of the Omar Shriners, Branchville Masonic Lodge #110 A.F.M., and Rivelon Baptist Church in Orangeburg. He was also a member of the 700 Club. He served in the U.S. Air Force for 12 years. He was a retired captain from the Orangeburg County Sheriff's Department, the U.S. Marshall Service, and retired Police Chief of the Branchville Police Department.
