Joe O. Barnhill, 79 years of age died April 7, 2021 at C.M. Tucker Nursing Care Center-Stone VA in Columbia. Mr. Barnhill was born October 10, 1941, in Aynor SC a son of the late Bennie B. Barnhill and Myrtie Hamilton Barnhill. He served in the US Army during the Dominican Republic and Vietnam Wars. He retired from American Yard Products, formally known as Roper Cooperation in Orangeburg with 36 years of service. He was a faithful member of Mt.
