Larry Dale Timms, 67 years of age, passed away on Monday, June 5th. Larry was the son of Junior and Doris Timms of Abbeville. A graduate of the 1968 class of Greenwood High School, he served four years in the Army National Guard while attending Lander College where, in 1973, he received a Bachelor of Arts in English.

Larry was employed by Greenwood Mills at locations in Greenwood and Orangeburg for 22 years. Following the closing of the Orangeburg plants, he worked for several other companies in management and retail sales before retiring from Ott Oil Company in 2012.
