Lloyd A. Connelly, 96 years of age, died Friday, July 26, 2019, at the VA Hospital, in Columbia. Mr. Connelly was born November 18, 1922, in Reevesville, a son of the late John Wesley Connelly, and Maggie Myers Connelly. He served his country faithfully in WWII. He was a lifelong farmer and a faithful member of Mt. Tabor Baptist Church, where he served as the church Historian, deacon, building committee, Sunday School Superintendent, and teacher. He was married to the late Catherine McAlhany Connelly for 65 years.

Funeral Services will be conducted Sunday, July 28, 2019, at 4:00 P.M., at Mt. Tabor Baptist Church, with Rev. Bobby Etheridge officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery.
