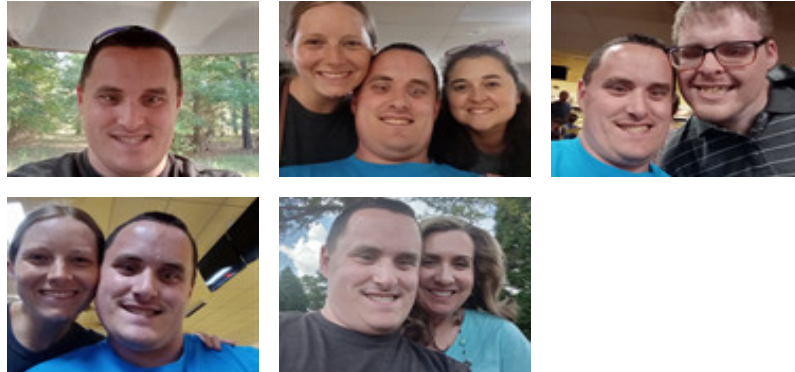
Ott Funeral Home in Branchville, S. C. will be assisting the family.
